



Analysis of the conservation status and management of savannas and grasslands, and stakeholder identification for a regional platform

Context

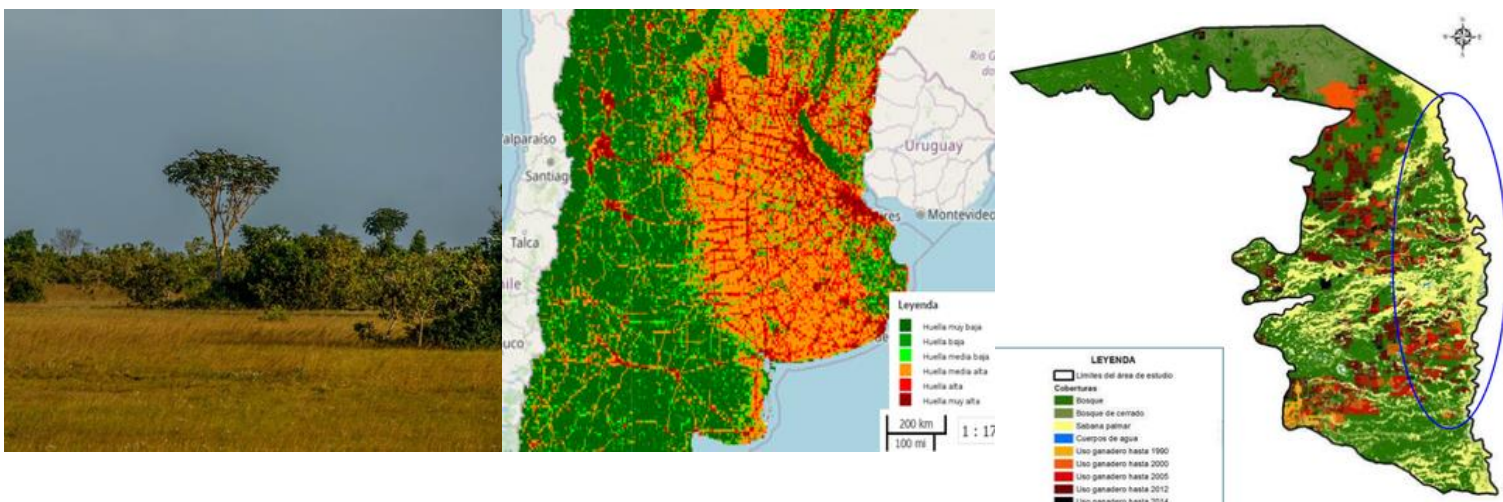
This consultancy was carried out under the project “Safeguarding Overlooked Ecosystems: Protect, Manage and Restore Grasslands and Savannas in Colombia, Paraguay and Argentina through multisectoral engagement and knowledge-sharing,” which has the objective to protect, restore, and sustainably manage grassland and savanna ecosystems in the Humid Chaco, Orinoquía, Pampas, and Pantanal regions of Argentina, Colombia, and Paraguay, promoting their integration as key ecosystems in policy agendas and within productive landscapes.

Project Description

This consultancy aimed to provide services for conducting a regional analysis of the conservation status, management, and threats to priority savannas, grasslands, and other grazing areas in South America, as well as identifying and characterizing the main strategic stakeholders related to these areas. SELVAR carried out the following work:

Results

- Characterization of the current status and challenges regarding conservation, restoration, and use of priority savannas, grasslands, and grazing areas in the region under the project.
- Identification of key and strategic stakeholders involved in the conservation, restoration, and sustainable use of these ecosystems, highlighting their roles and potential for generating synergies.
- Systematization of information on 80 existing initiatives related to the conservation, restoration, management, and sustainable use of these priority areas, analyzing their outputs, results, impact, financing mechanisms, and lessons learned.
- Systematization of 60 knowledge-management mechanisms carried out for the implementation of the identified grassland initiatives, focusing on exchange activities, capacity building, among others.
